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
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
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

Camarena Health has proudly served patients in the communities of Madera County for over 35 years, with locations in Madera, Chowchilla, and Oakhurst.



























Camarena Health is proud of another successful year of growth marked by expanded access to preventive healthcare services in our communities and the continued development of its medical training programs. The year of 2016 started with the launch of our new Optometry Program in Madera, allowing us to provide quality, convenient, and affordable vision services to our patients and the community. We successfully expanded Behavioral Health services to all eight of our locations, opened our Urgent Care Center doors, and ended the year by launching dental services in our Oakhurst Dental Center. The addition of new and expanded services allows us to continue the development of an integrated, patient-centered medical home for the communities we are privileged to serve.

Further, in our effort to address the primary care workforce shortage in the Central Valley, we had the pleasure of welcoming our first class of five Physician Assistant students to

begin training with Camarena Health through our affiliation with AT Still University. We have also formed strategic partnerships and affiliations with our local universities, including UC San Francisco (UCSF) and Fresno State (CSU Fresno), to provide clinical rotations, experience, and training to their Nurse Practitioner students.

This past year Camarena Health has moved closer to having each of its medical facilities recognized as a Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA). This recognition demonstrates that Camarena Health delivers primary care that is patient-centered, comprehensive, team-based, coordinated, accessible and focused on quality.

We are privileged to serve our communities, and we take great pride in the continued expansion and delivery of quality services to our patients. Our training programs are made possible through valuable partnerships, collaborations and the continued support we have in our local community and throughout the Central Valley. We understand that without them, Camarena Health would not be able to do all that we do. Patient Experience Surveys

As a Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH), soliciting patient feedback is critical, not only to our growth, but also to demonstrate our commitment to achieve the highest level of quality indicators possible. Not only does Camarena Health actively survey nearly half its patients (thousands per quarter), but these patient experience surveys serve as the standard by which internal employee and provider evaluations are conducted. Our specialized data-analyzing software allows us to identify in real time any opportunities for growth and improvement in regards to our services, facilities and staff/patient interaction. Camarena Health believes the patient should have a positive experience at each and every visit, as we hold ourselves to the highest of standards in delivering exceptional service.

Camarena Health is dedicated to our patients and communities. It is our promise to provide the highest quality, innovative, patient-centered care in an effort to exceed the needs of the individuals and families we serve. Every year we explore additional ways we can add value to those in our communities while improving their health and experience when visiting our health centers.



Focus Groups

Camarena Health has substantially grown in our ability to serve the various needs of the community by adding new services, expanding and improving existing services, and/or expanding locations. One of the ways we've been able to accomplish this is by soliciting discussions via annual focus groups in all the communities that we are proud to serve. These focus groups are conducted both in Spanish and English to ensure every patient has a voice and an opportunity for their suggestions to be heard by Camarena leadership. The purpose of these focus groups is to create an environment where community members can share their ideas, concerns, and unique needs in a constructive and positive forum. Data collected from focus groups have led to the emergence of services such as Behavioral Health, Urgent Care, and Optometry, as well as expansion of service sites.

In 2016, Camarena Health moved closer to the goal of having each of our sites recognized through the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) as a Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH).

Our goal is to make the healthcare process easy and comfortable in a way that works best for the patient. As the patient's primary healthcare provider, Camarena Health establishes a personal partnership with the patient while delivering comprehensive, quality care. We engage and empower each patient to actively participate in their own health and wellness. Camarena Health utilizes Care Teams, which consist of healthcare professionals with specific roles. The Care Team members coordinate and provide individualized care based on the specific needs of the patient.

Organizational initiatives in 2016 that have helped our organization's progression towards a PCMH model include: a partnership with UC Davis in the Medical Assistant Health Coach program, patient pre-visit planning, motivational interviewing, integration of Behavioral Health into our primary medical care, and focusing efforts on whole person delivery of care.

Medical Assistant (MA) Health Coaches

At Camarena Health, we are committed to providing the highest level of quality care. This dedication can be found in our collaboration with UC Davis in the Medical Assistant (MA) Health Coach program. The UC Davis MA Health Coach program equips our MAs with health education skills to assist patients with chronic conditions such as diabetes, hypertension, asthma, etc. In addition to expanding their knowledge of chronic conditions, MAs are trained to further develop their soft skills, such as effective communication with patients, patient engagement, motivational interviewing, and more. The goal of the MA Health Coach model enables MAs to broaden their professional skills by assisting patients in developing a care plan and self-management goals.

Insurance Enrollment

Many of our patients, including the general community, do not understand or realize the insurance options they have available to them. Navigating through this complex system can be confusing and frustrating due to requirements and requests for documentation. Camarena Health has deployed Insurance Enrollment Specialists at several locations to ensure our patients receive the help they need to enroll in insurance, and subsequently receive coverage.



Insurance Enrollment Specialists facilitate the application process from beginning to end for many insurance programs, including commercial, State, and special insurance programs, including our Sliding Fee Scale Program.

ANNUAL YOUTH 2016 CONFERENCE

As a healthcare provider in the Central Valley, we are faced with the reality of having an extreme healthcare professional shortage in primary care. One way we began to address this issue was by collaborating with Madera County High Schools focusing on Career Technical Education (CTE) and Health Care Pathway Programs. By working closely with high schools and CTE programs, we have been able to expose more students and teachers to the various health professions in primary care.

In 2016, Camarena Health facilitated the HEALTH CAREERS START HERE-MADERA YOUTH CONFERENCE. The conference hosted 150 high school students from Madera County, and allowed students to interact with local healthcare professionals. The workshops provided students with an understanding of the education, cost, and growth opportunities associated with each of the professions.

Over 20 healthcare professionals joined our conference in 2016 in an effort to educate and inspire students to pursue a career in health care. Topics included:

(Alzheimer's Disease, Sexual Health, Financial Health)




Physician Assistant clinical residency program














Camarena Health is affiliated with the A.T. Still University's Physician Assistant (PA) Program as a community health center campus for clinical education. In August of 2016, five 2nd-year PA students were placed in our health centers for their clinical learning year.



The PA Clinical Residency Program provides one year of hands-on, intense clinical learning modules rotating every six weeks. The students in this program must complete and excel in the following clinical rotation areas:

urgent isn't always an emergency

In 2016, we proudly opened the first comprehensive Urgent Care facility located in Madera. Consistent with our mission, we solicited feedback from our patients and the community on their unmet healthcare needs. The resounding responses were clear. They asked for an affordable and accessible Urgent Care facility to meet their healthcare needs at times when a typical medical practice would be closed. Left with no options, community members were utilizing the hospital Emergency Room for visits that were more appropriate to address in an Urgent Care setting. Camarena Health responded by providing a comprehensive Urgent Care facility that is open nights and weekends and offers X-Ray services. Our commitment to our community is evident by not only offering this service to our patients, but the entire community as well.











The lack of affordable and convenient vision services in Madera was an additional concern of our patients. Our community members and patients voiced their desire to have access to a full-service Optometry department that meets the ongoing needs of their families and accepts their insurance. The community looked to Camarena Health to meet their current need, and, once again, Camarena Health responded. Built in 2016, Camarena Health's Optometry department now offers a full array of Optometry services, including eye exams, diabetic retinopathy screenings, and dispensing of eye wear. Camarena Health's Optometry department offers a variety of eyewear for children, women, and men, including protective and sports eyewear.


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ADVOCACY

Camarena Health developed the "I Heart Camarena Advocacy Campaign" to engage and educate our patients, staff, and community members on ways they can be advocates for Camarena Health and community health centers across the nation.

The "I Heart Camarena Advocacy Campaign" reached over 200 individuals who were interested in being Camarena Health advocates by sharing their personal stories of why they "HEART CAMARENA." They also received alerts on state and national opportunities to engage in advocacy through letter writing, calling elected officials, and joining Camarena Health to educate on the importance of community health centers.
